SITE INSPECTION REPORT/SATISFACTORY REPORT

The undersigned inspected the plantation site at Kharkhari Jatmal and Jainpur under South West Range on 28.07.2026 regarding the work of 1st year maintenance of 2,09,200 plantation through Miyawaki Technique being carried out under West Forest Division through M/s Agrisense Landscape as per Work Order dated 04.12.2025.

During the site inspection carried out by the undersigned at Kharkhari Jatmal and Jainpur plantation site, it was observed that the maintenance work is being executed by the agency satisfactorily as per the terms & conditions of the work order and field requirements. The plantation area was found properly maintained and necessary maintenance operations were being carried out regularly for healthy growth and survival of plants.

During inspection, it was observed that the agency had deployed 209 Nos. labours for carrying out various plantation maintenance activities such as watering, weeding, hoeing, soil working, cleaning around plants, removal of unwanted vegetation, and application of manure, pest control measures, and protection of plants. The labour deployment was found adequate considering the size and spread of the plantation area, and the workforce was actively engaged in maintenance operations at site during inspection.

It was further observed that regular watering was being carried out through water tankers as per field requirement and climatic conditions to maintain adequate moisture for healthy growth of plants. Proper irrigation is essential for root development, nutrient absorption, and prevention of moisture stress, especially during dry weather conditions. The watering arrangement made by the agency was found satisfactory and necessary for sustenance of the plantation.

The labourers deployed by the agency were found actively engaged in routine maintenance activities. The plantation area was generally clean and properly maintained. However, at a few locations some plants were found under stress due to environmental conditions. Necessary directions were issued to the concerned agency and field staff to undertake immediate corrective measures, including regular watering, proper soil working, cleaning around plants, and timely casualty replacement wherever required.

The agency has also applied vermicompost/manure as per requirement to improve soil fertility and enhance microbial activity in the soil. Application of vermicompost improves soil texture, water retention capacity, and availability of essential nutrients like nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium, thereby supporting healthy plant growth and increasing survival percentage.

During physical verification of the plantation area, the overall condition, health, and growth of the plantation were found satisfactory. The present survival rate of the plantation is approximately 91%, which is considered satisfactory at this stage of maintenance. It was



observed that casualty replacement is presently under process, and the concerned agency has been directed to complete the replacement of all casualty plants before the end of the monsoon season so as to ensure optimum stocking, better establishment, and enhanced survival of the plantation. The field staff have also been instructed to closely monitor the replacement work and ensure regular aftercare, watering, and maintenance of the newly replaced plants.

Overall, the maintenance work of 2,09,200 plantation at Kharkhari Jatmal and Jainpur under 1st year maintenance being executed by M/s Agrisense Landscape was found satisfactory during the course of inspection. The agency was advised to continue all maintenance operations as per the Work Order and the directions issued by the Department to ensure healthy growth and long-term sustainability of the plantation.
